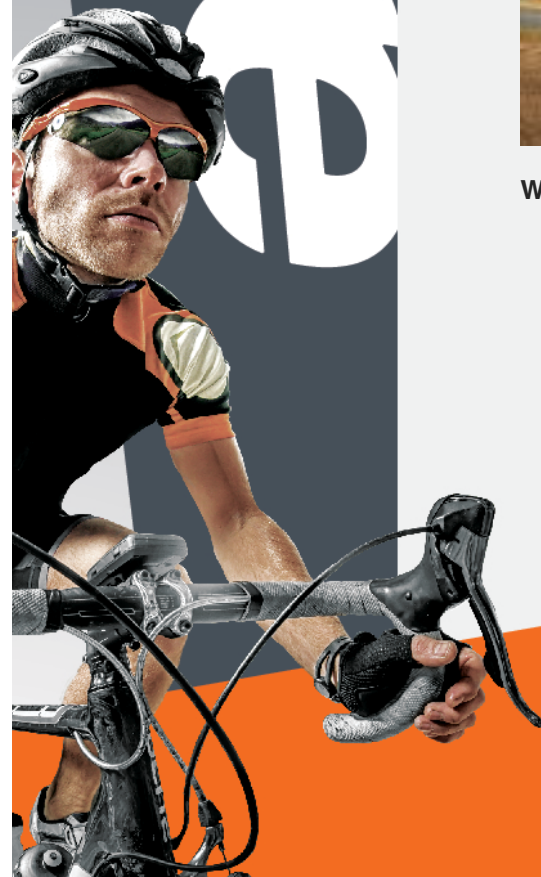

What's on Offer

1. 3-days riding (around 328 k) ... all road routes
2. 2 night's accommodation at the exclusive Tinonee Vineyard Estate 25 and 26 October
3. breakfast 26 and 27 October
4. morning tea and lunch 25, 26, 27 October
5. chef prepared dinners evening of 25 and 26 October
6. wine tour afternoon of 26 October
7. complimentary wine from 1813 (within reason)
8. on road food and support, including baggage transfers to and from Tinonee Vineyard Estate

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Routes

Day 1 is a 115 k 1546 VM route from Mt White to Broke, with morning tea at Kulnura 43 k and Lunch at Wollombi 85 k followed by wine tasting and in-house chef's dinner at Tinonee Vineyard Estate.

Day 2 is a scenic 108 k 906 VM loop around Broke and Singleton, with morning tea at Singleton 75 k and lunch post ride followed by a wine tour in the afternoon in Broke, followed once again by wine tasting and an in-house chef's dinner at Tinonee Vineyard estate.

Day 3 is the same as Day 1, albeit without the Mooney Mooney climb, which reduces the distance from 115 k to 105 k 1415 VM. Morning tea will be at Laguna 38 k and lunch will be at Kulnura 73 k.

At this stage, the start and finish will be from Saddles in Mount White, 20 Ashbrookes Rd, Mt White NSW.

Cars can be left in all day street parking and we can grab a quick coffee before we depart and do a final rider briefing. The café opens at 8 am and I reckon we should depart no later than 8.30 am so please arrive no later than 7.45 am to make that happen.

Things to think About

1. This is not a sanctioned event and rider insurance is not mandatory but it is recommended. Its crazy to ride on the road without some form of cover. Cycling Australia offers month by month cover at less than \$10 a month and it would be a good idea to organise a RIDE BASIC cover if you currently don't have any insurance.

2. We aren't taking a mechanic, so it would be nice to ensure your bike is in good working condition. New tubes, tyres and a service tweak will ensure you have a solid chance of getting through the 3 days.
3. Bring whatever you would normally take to self manage mechanical repairs; as if you were doing a weekend ride with mates.
4. Make sure your bike can carry 2 water bottles to prevent unnecessary stops.
5. The event will cover all food, on road food and bits.
6. Tinonee will provide each of you with 1 x complimentary bottle of wine from a selection of their stock plus 1 complimentary wine tasting on arrival and your rider fee also includes a gourmet wine and cheese tour of Margan Wines Broke.
7. If its raining, the plan will be to ride, unless crazy and we deem it to be dangerous. We will monitor this on a day by day basis; so bring weather for all seasons.
8. Pack a bag but please don't pack it like you going away for 3 weeks.

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Conditions of Entry

All participants in the 1813 Ride of the Vines are required to read and sign these conditions of entry. By signing this document, you are stating you fully understand and agree to these conditions of entry and individual responsibilities as set out by the event management company Entoure and all volunteers and employees of Entoure.

- 1(a) *I, the undersigned, in consideration of and as a condition of acceptance of my entry in the ride for myself, my heirs, executors and administrators hereby waive all and any claim, right or cause of action which I or they might otherwise have for or arising out of my loss of life, damage or loss of any description whatsoever which I may suffer or sustain in the course of or consequent upon my entry or participation in the said event AND I agree that I participate in the said event solely at my own risk.*
- 1(b) *I acknowledge that the ride will be held on public roads which are in use by the general public during the ride and I agree to abide by any law relating to the use of public roads. I acknowledge that riding on a public road is inherently dangerous and I am aware of the risks of collision with motor vehicles, bicycles or pedestrians and agree to exercise proper care and skill to avoid any collision. I am also aware of the risks of crashing due to uneven surfaces, potholes or gravel.*
- 2. *This waiver, release and discharge shall be and operate separately in favour of all persons, corporations and bodies involved or otherwise engaged in promoting or staging the event and the servants, agents, representatives and officers of them, any host, first aid, medical and paramedical personnel, police officers and shall operate whether or not the loss, injury or damage is attributable to the act or neglect of any one or more of them.*
- 3. *I hereby acknowledge that I have sole responsibility for my personal possessions and equipment during the ride, as well as the transportation of my bike to and from the event, and if deemed necessary, during the ride itself. Entoure accepts no responsibility at any stage for my bike or for my possessions.*
- 4. *I hereby attest and verify that I am physically fit and have sufficiently trained for this ride and can ride safely at the agreed base level of fitness and rider experience for this event (estimated at 23 k ave). If requested, I agree to provide a signed doctor's certificate attesting to my physical health and fitness to participate in this ride and if requested, attend a qualification training ride to qualify. I also agree to abide by the organizers decisions if I am unable to maintain the agreed pace of my fellow riders and deemed to be a risk on the road to myself or others.*
- 5. *I hereby consent to receive medical treatment, which may be deemed necessary in the event due to injury, accident and/or illness during the ride.*
- 6. *If requested, I agree to present my bike before the ride at the times to be advised to allow it to be inspected and will abide the decision of the organizers as to ride-worthiness or suitability for the ride. Notwithstanding such an inspection, I acknowledge that I at all times remain responsible for ensuring that my bike is ride-worthy, has been properly maintained and serviced and is in a suitable condition to be able to undertake the ride safely*
- 7. *Under no circumstances whilst riding my bike will I listen to MP3 Players / music and or have ear buds of any kind reducing my ability to hear ride captains, other riders and or traffic around me and others.*
- 8. *I understand I need to ride safely in a group alongside other riders and I need a road / race bike in good working condition to participate in this ride and that no hybrids, mountain bikes, tri bars, tandems, recumbent bikes are allowed. Road E Bikes are allowed in this event.*
- 9. *I acknowledge this event is not sanctioned by Cycling Australia or any other authorities and that my participation in this event is at my risk; no different to a ride with my mates and that entoure is simply providing logistical support as agreed.*
- 10. *I understand and accept that the event has a zero-alcohol policy whilst cycling and that under no circumstances will I consume alcohol during the ride.*
- 12. *I have read these Conditions of Entry and agree to abide by them.*
- 13. *"Ride" means The 1813 Ride of the Vines..*
